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Dear Parent/Carer

In line with the latest Government guidance, any child or adult living in a household with a person who displays the symptoms of 'a fever or a new, continuous cough' should now self-isolate, (as a household), for 14 days.

Please be advised that we currently have several staff absent due to either self or family isolation, with the potential for this to increase for those individuals classed as high risk due to underlying health conditions.

Should any parent choose to self-isolate their child, would you please ensure that the school are advised immediately, with a clear explanation of the symptoms, so that we may monitor any absence for this reason. Your child will need to self-isolate and remain at home for the recommended time, currently 14 days.

In the event of self-isolation or a school closure, children will be expected to continue their learning and to facilitate this we have provided the following resources:

Your child will use their usual login to access their home page for pre-set learning activities. They will also need to visit their class Forum page where they will find other home learning activities. These pages will be viewed by teachers and additional activities provided during the closure period.

Learning activities have been set and will continue to be added as your child progresses through the activities. Teachers will monitor progress and leave comments to support your child with their learning.
- **Times tables** should be practised daily to consolidate understanding and speed of recall. DB primary and MyMaths should be used as part of this learning.
- **Projects** - The class projects which have been set this term should be continued. If your child has completed one of the project options then please select one of the other possible activities to enhance their learning.



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- **Reading** – Daily reading is essential to maintain the progress that the children have made.
Books should be reread for fluency. Comprehension activities have been uploaded onto DB Primary on the class homepage in the files folder. Children also have access to Oxford Owl website where they can locate additional books to read.
For those children who have CGP books please complete two pages each week during the school closure.
- **Writing** – Writing activities have been loaded onto DB Primary on the class homepage in the files folder. Please check that the children are meeting their targets set with you last term.

Please speak to the class teacher if you are unsure of how to access any of the above as these activities will reduce the impact that any self-isolation or forced closure will have on your child's education.
