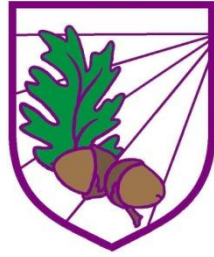

Dear Parent / Carer

As you are aware from midnight on Wednesday 4th November the country will go into lockdown again, but this time schools will remain open and continue to provide a regular routine and education for all children.

At Oak View we are making some adjustments to ensure our school community stays as safe as possible during this period.

- 1. All parents / carers to wear a face mask while on the school site. Drop off and pick up times.**
- 2. No parents / carers will be allowed inside the school building unless requested by the Head teacher. Please contact the school office, if needed, by phone or email.**
- 3. If you need to collect your child for an appointment, please call the office as you arrive at school so that we can arrange for the child to be ready to meet you outside the Reception door.**
- 4. All communication will be sent via text, email, website or newsletter**
- 5. Parents evening will take place online, using a Zoom like approach.**

If you have siblings throughout the school we have adopted a soft start to support our families, **BUT** if you do not have siblings please do not arrive until your time allocation. e.g. Reception Class 8.50am.

Also due to the restrictions all school apparatus will be out of bounds before or after the school day. Pupils are NOT allowed to play on the climbing frames at the end of day. We saw an increase in this at the end of last half term and ask parents to support us in managing their safety.
