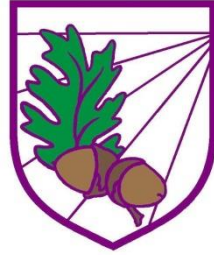

1. School will return to original timings (School gate and classrooms will open at 8.40am)

Year Group	Start Time	Finish time
Reception	8.50am	3.10pm
Year 1 and Year 2	8.50am	3.10pm
Year 3, 4, 5 and 6	8.50am	3.15pm

Nursery and Reception children will receive a reminder via schoolcomms/text detailing their transition timetable for the beginning of September.

2. Expectations of all children in **full school uniform** will return. School uniform consists of a school jumper, white polo shirt, charcoal grey or black trousers/skirt, purple and white gingham summer dress and plain black shoes.

No tracksuit bottoms, sports tops or trainers will be allowed.

3. PE days will remain with children allowed to come to school in sportswear for the day. PE kit consists of a white t-shirt, black shorts/tracksuit bottoms and black plimsolls/trainers. This has been a positive change during the year.
