

Miss Prentice, Deputy Head, will be missed and I am sure you will agree she has been a great support to pupils, families and staff. As a member of the Senior Leadership team, I would like to acknowledge her dedication and commitment to Oak View. Thank you, we wish you all the best for the future.

The Year 6 children have been performing in their fabulous production of Robin Hood and have their final performance this evening. We look forward to seeing our Year 6 parents at their special Leaver's Assembly on Thursday 21st July at 10.30am.

On Friday 15th July, we will be having a whole school picnic for the children in **Reception to Year 6** to enjoy spending time with those staff leaving. The school meal option will be a cold packed lunch only of either ham, cheese or tuna which the children can choose on the day.

The children will have their class parties next week; KS2 on Wednesday 20th July and KS1/ Reception classes on Thursday 21st July. Children may wear their own clothes on their party day.

May I also remind parents that the cost of a school meal will increase to £2.35 per day with effect from September 2016. We are also considering becoming a 'cashless' school in the Autumn Term when all payments will be made online so you may wish to start using this facility in September.

We wish all our families a happy summer break and we look forward to seeing the children return, refreshed and ready to start the new school year, on Thursday 1st September (Nursery children start on Monday 5th September).
