

PSED

We will continue to talk about school rules and routines to ensure that we can be the best that we can be. We will share with our class what we do at the weekends and special times that we spend with our family.

We will also be looking at how we can keep ourselves safe in school and out. We will also be looking at how other people help us. We will be talking about how it makes us feel to help others.

Physical

In PE this half term the children will be continue to learn Children's Yoga on a Friday. In addition to this children will begin to learn the PE routine, as well as health and safety. We will be learning some simple ring games and group games this half term. Children will begin to learn the routine of rolling snack; this means that children will be responsible for their own hygiene and taking snack when they are hungry. Children will be reminded to wash their hands thoroughly before eating.

CL

We will continue to develop our communication through speaking and listening activities that take place in class at circle times and carpet sessions. We will be learning new vocabulary related to our castles and fairy tales topic. We will be using story language to role play the story of "Jack and the Beanstalk" and "Cinderella". Children will continue to be encouraged to talk about their likes and dislikes, and talk to others in the classroom.

Summer Term 1 2017

Maths

In maths this half term the children will be looking at recognising and counting numbers 1-20. The children will continue to count forwards and start to count backwards. .

In shape, space and measure the children will consolidate their learning about 2D shapes and their properties. They will also be learning how to make simple patterns and how to measure in a variety of simple ways.

Literacy

The children will continue to learn phase 2 letter sounds during phonics and will start to practise blending order to read simple words.

Through the use of non-fiction books the children will learn about castles, they will then begin to be encouraged to label their pictures or paintings of their castles.

The children will read stories and hear stories orally of "The princess and the pea", "Cinderella", and "Jack and the Beanstalk". We will talk about classic fairy-tale beginnings and endings.

UW

This half term explores fairy tales. The children will be learning about how to grow plants through learning the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. The children will learn what is needed to make plants grow and how to look after them so that they produce crops (vegetables). We will also continue to explore forest school.

EAD

This half term the children will be exploring colours by mixing them to create new colours. The children will also be doing some observational drawings of castles they have built themselves..

The children will also use a range of media and materials to make their own crowns, and props for role-play.

The children will continue to develop their role play through stories and learn some new songs and dances related to the topic.
