In order to achieve these objectives we will/have:

- **Employed 2 Senior Teaching Assistants to provide one-one/group support for targeted pupils. Their remit includes making and purchasing resources to enhance learning and to support other staff in delivering quality language development.**
- **1-1 targeted support by Senior Leader for children in KS1**
- **For all staff to audit the quality of provision in school and identify the key areas for Challenge Award Action Plan**
- **Professional Development – visiting similar schools with a high level of ethnic minorities**
- **Professional Development – SLT to visit schools who have developed a Growth Mindset.**
- **Fund after school clubs (TAS) and Breakfast Club**
- **Fund counselling and pupil support(parent worker)**
- **Fund increased admin time for attendance follow up**
- **Fund Rapid Reading Teaching Assistant**
- **To fund enrichment of the Arts towards the Arts Mark**
