This term our theme is

Champions of Change: The Victorians

Science

This term we will be looking at how plants and animals are classified. The children will develop an understanding of the work of Carl Linnaeus. In the second half of the term the focus will be on the human circulatory system. Pupils will look at the function of the heart and how blood flows around the body.

PE

The children will developing their fitness and practising their invasion skills through lacrosse and tag rugby sessions

Computing

The children will be learning how use the internet for research, finding and presenting relevant information.



Spanish

In Spanish the children will be learning vocabulary relating to introducing themselves and they will also learn how to present the weather.



Literacu

This term we will be developing aspects of narrative writing and producing extended stories.



We will also be writing autobiographies and comparing these with biographical accounts. We will be working on the quality of all written work with a particular focus on joined, fluent writing and varied sentence structure.



Year 6 Curriculum overview

Mathematics

This term we will begin with revision of place value and key number skills.

The children should become more familiar with calculations involving decimals, and develop more advanced skills with formal calculations. We will then move on to ways of representing data, including the use of pie charts. Pupils in Year 6 will be expected to practise their multiplication tables regularly and apply this knowledge with confidence.

Geography



We will be covering the geography curriculum next term through our topic of natural disasters and North America.

History

We will be studying significant changes that happened during the Victorian era, including technological and social advances. We will also look at the lives of some famous Victorians and their impact on society.

Art and DT



Our focus this term will be on the Arts and Crafts Movement, particularly the work of William Morris and Charles Rennie Mackintosh We will be

developing skills using sketching, clay, paint and needlework.

Music

The children will be exploring beat, pitch and syncopation to build a larger scale performance.

RE



This year our focus will be Christianity and Buddhism. During this term we will consider basics of

the Buddhist faith, and the early life of Buddha. We will also examine sacred and secular aspects of Christmas celebrations.
