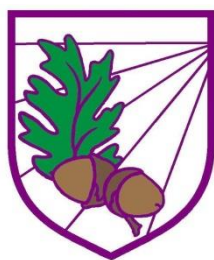

Christmas at Oak View 2024

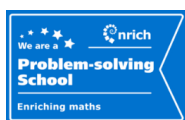
Dear Parents/Carers,

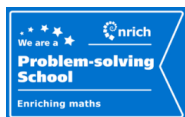
Thank you again for your support over this last term. I hope we can have a fun and festive end to the Autumn term with all children enjoying the Christmas activities planned.
