ROAD SAFETY - WOODS AVENUE



Last week, the Headteachers from Bishops Secondary, Southfields, St. Phillip Howard, along with myself, met with local councillors and HHC transport leaders to address the growing concerns around traffic congestion on Woods Avenue during drop-off and pick-up times. The situation has worsened recently, significantly raising the risk of a potential incident. While there isn't a quick and obvious solution, all schools are urging parents to park only in designated, safe spaces (avoiding double yellow lines), to cross the road at appropriate locations with their children, and to exercise patience during periods of heavy traffic.







After half term the school will again be promoting, "Be Bright, Be Seen", campaign, which is the annual road safety initiative to encourage wearing bright and reflective clothing, especially during darker months when visibility is poor. Please support this, speak to your children and look for small reflective items to put on their jackets / bags
