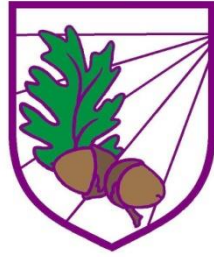

Work will be published every morning at 9am, with a welcome email from the class teacher. The class teacher will again email at 12.30pm to check in on the children and give guidance if required. The Foundation Stage timetable will be the same for every child.

Year group staff have been split into teams with one teacher and TA working in school direct teaching vulnerable / key worker children and the other team working remotely supporting all the pupils who are online.

Additional to the education support each child will have a personal email / check in with the class teacher each week on DB Primary. This is to check on their welfare, ask how work is going and in general a touch base support tool. We hope this will be a positive support for all our children.
